Health and safety considerations for 'additional' children in school during the school day

Children are welcome in school providing our health and safety guidelines are adhered to:

- Permission has been obtained for children to be in school before and after the school contact hours
- In the event of an occasional day, please seek permission from Headteacher for an additional child to be in school
- Please ensure that children are signed in the visitors book by the office
- We expect all children to abide by the Golden Rules

- Children remain the responsibility of their parent/or a named adult at all times and therefore should be with them at all times
- Children are welcome to go outside after school or during break times providing their parent is with them
- Children are welcome to join the other children at lunchtime, in the hall and in the playground, providing their parent/or a named adult is with them
- Please do not give any codes to the classroom doors to any children, they should not be using them under any circumstances
- Children coming into school at the beginning or the end of the day are reminded that teachers are working and should therefore occupy themselves quietly.

Friends Events

Children are welcome in school providing our health and safety guidelines are adhered to:

- We expect all children to abide by the *Golden Rules*
- Children remain the responsibility of their parent/or a named adult at all times and therefore should be with them at all times
- Please do not give any codes to the classroom doors to any children, they should not be using them under any circumstances
- Children coming into school at the beginning or the end of the day are reminded that teachers are working and should therefore occupy themselves quietly
- Space will be provided in the library, for children to store their school bags, get changed and/or eat their tea
- If required, a dvd will be available in a classroom.
- Staff room will be out of bounds for children
